Food & Drink


The George Grill, overlooking the high street, offers modern British food with European accents. The menu delivers a delicious combination of the classically-inspired with the contemporary, predominantly cooked on the wood charcoal grill. Ingredients are sourced from local farms in Rye, Sussex and Kent and much of the fish and seafood is caught in the Rye Bay. Next to the restaurant, The George Tap serves real ales, draught ciders and a wide selection of wines from around the world as well as some from local vineyards. In the summer months the bar opens out onto a pretty courtyard garden.



Transportation:

By Air:

London Gatwick Airport (52 minutes SE)

By Rail:

London St Pancras International to Ashford International (37 minutes). Change at Ashford International for Rye, Sussex (20 minutes). The George is a few minutes' walk from Rye Railway station.

By Road:

Take the M25 (eastbound) to Junction 5, then M26 to M20. Take the M20 to Junction 10. Take the A2070 to Lydd & Brenzett. Follow the A2070 to Brookland roundabout (Total Petrol Station). Follow the A259 for Rye.
